Inclement Weather Policy (Golf)

Purpose of Policy.

Inclement weather can present as a hazard to Club Members' health, safety and wellbeing whilst playing golf. Inclement weather under this policy includes Heat, Wind, Lightning, Fog & Smoke. "The club" is committed to providing a safe and healthy environment that takes into consideration the needs of staff, members and visitors including those who may suffer from pre-existing conditions.

Personnel authorized to action items/item of this policy include (in order of authority)

- The most senior match committee member on-premises, and not playing golf.
- The most senior staff member on-premises.

Notifications

- Safety Siren (delivered from the clubhouse siren or handheld horn)
 - One long blast. Play suspended, all players MUST return to the clubhouse immediately. In the case of lightning, make their way back to the clubhouse and exercise caution whilst doing so. If unable to do so, find a low area, trench or group of shrubs of uniform height.
 - Two long blasts. Players can return to play.
 - Three short blasts. Play abandoned for the day.

Heat

Our temperature data is collected from the golf course weather station.

Trigger point for heat to stop play:

If the feels like temperature exceeds 38.0 degrees, play will be suspended. When the feels like temperature drops below 36.0 degrees, play can resume.

Wind

Our wind data is collected from the golf course weather station

Play will be suspended following one wind gust reading exceeding 65kms per hour. Players must mark their ball and return immediately to inside the clubhouse and await further instruction. Resumption of play will require one hour of wind speed readings below 60kms per hour. In circumstances when wind speeds are less or more than 65kms per hour, and considered dangerous, discretion to suspend play rests with the most senior authorised person on-premises.

Lightning

Our lightning data is collected from Lightning Maps

Trigger point for lightning to stop play:

- When lightning is within 15 kilometres, and trending towards the course.
- When a player believes there is danger from lightening, even though no siren has been sounded. (See Rule of Golf 6-8).

Members/Players will:

- Stop playing immediately, mark the ball.
- Make their way back to the Clubhouse and exercise caution whilst doing so.

- If out in the open and unable to return to the clubhouse, find a low area, trench or group of shrubs of uniform height. Keep away from boundary areas between dissimilar terrain (water and land; rock and earth; trees and fields). Also keep at least five metres away from metal objects or other people as lightning will often jump from one object to another.

Fog or Smoke

Trigger point to suspend play:

- Play will not commence or will be suspended if the first green is not visible from the first tee (blue tee). Play may recommence when it is visible.

Count Back: Deciding ties in events:

Ties in events shall be decided whenever possible by replay, but if the Committee considers otherwise the following count-back method shall be used:

1. For 18 hole events the best score for the last 9 holes shall be used, if there is still a tie the last 6 holes or if still tied the last 3 holes. If a tie still persists then hole by hole from the 18th.
2. In 27, 36, 54 and 72 hole events the last 18 holes shall be used and if still tied count-back as 1, above.
3. In handicap events the relevant handicap or fraction thereof shall be applied.
4. Where a penalty applicable under Rule 3-5 of the Rules of Golf is applied to a result this penalty shall be ignored so far as the count- back is concerned. NOTE: For a 9 hole event the best score for the last 6 holes shall be used, if there is still a tie the last 3 holes, if a tie still persists then hole by hole from the 9th hole.

Stableford:

Mark at each hole the number of strokes actually taken. If the net score of any players is more than one greater than the Standard Scratch for that hole, he should pick up his ball.

The Stableford score is ascertained as follows:

- If the net score at hole 1 over S.S.S., 1 pt.
- If net score at hole equals S.S.S., 2 pts.
- If net score at hole is 1 less than S.S.S., 3 pts.

Club Championships - Men

Club Championship Handicaps:

Grades are determined by the number of entries and evenly distributed by handicap. Total field divided by four.

Grades: Open, B Grade, C Grade, D Grade.

A Player's daily handicap on the day of the first round of the Club Championships will determine his division irrespective of handicap changes during the course of the Championships. To enter the club championships, you place your name and golf link number on the sheet on the noticeboard.

Ties after the final round in each division will be decided by sudden death playoff using holes 1, 2, 8 and 9. Should the match be tied, sudden death playoff will begin and be played over the same holes. Net results will be determined on a countback.

Event Format

The A, B, C and D Grade Championship will be played over three rounds of Stroke Play.

Graeme Wilson Memorial Trophy

This event was initially used to honour the contribution to the Club by Tom Hackett. He was a five term President in the 1960's and was one of the driving forces behind junior golf and the bowls section of our Club. Graeme Wilson was a local pharmacist and a popular member of our Club. He went onto the Committee of Management and unfortunately in that first year became ill and passed away at the all too young age of 59. Graeme bequeathed to the Club a sum of money to enhance the 13th hole and in line with his wishes, the Club completed this task. A sign outlining his vision has been placed on the 13th Tee.

The best net score over the Championship (all grades) will be the winner of the Graeme Wilson Memorial Trophy and your name will be placed on the club honour board.

Four net aggregate events over Fifty-Four holes will be played in conjunction with the Club Championships for each grade and the winner will receive a \$20 club voucher.

Ties after Fifty-Four holes to be decided by the count back system.

Col McPherson Memorial Trophy

This event honours the contribution of Col McPherson to the establishment of our golf course. He was a member that was involved in the construction and development of the golf course. He and his good friend Bruce Savige were assigned to build the 14th green. The green was supposed to be a small kidney shaped green but many truckloads later it became what it is today day. Col continued working towards developing the course and was a very keen golfer.

The event is a handicap event and is presented to the best net score of a veteran golfer aged 55 or more. Entry in the event is automatic with the Championship entry. All ties are decided by countback.

Veterans Scratch Championship

This is the inaugural year of this event and it will be awarded to the best scratch score over fifty four holes of stroke play. In the event of a tie, a playoff over the 1st, 2nd, 8th and 9th holes will be played to decide the winner. The event this year is being sponsored by Peter Wilson and the Bairnsdale Veteran Golfers.

Junior Championship

This event has been long supported by Graeme and Maree Piera who have awarded the trophy since its inception.

JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIP - Fifty-Four Holes Gross Stroke Play
Players must be under 18 years as of the first round.

Championship Presentation of Trophies will be conducted on **Saturday 24th February 2024** at the completion of the days play.

Crowe-Wilson 4 Ball Knockout

This event honours the contribution of both Jack Crowe and Bob Wilson. Jack Crowe served as both President and Captain and work tirelessly on the golf course, making it better each year. In the wet years of 194-1975, Jack dug spoon drains down the third and fifth fairways to assist in drainage. Bob was a local businessman who served a term as President and was a tireless worker in raising funds for the Club.

Qualifying round is **Saturday 27th April 2024**

Additional Conditions of Play

1. Entry is on the day with a payment of \$2 per person made at the time of entry.
2. The top 16 pairs will qualify and enter a seeded draw. If there is a tie for 16th position, it will be decided by countback.
3. In each match, the player with the lower handicap plays off scratch. Their opponent's handicap is similarly reduced. Shots shall be taken off the stroke index on the score card. Maximum handicap is 36.
4. Competition to be played in accordance with the rules of golf.
5. All matches will be played on or before the due date unless prior approval has been granted by the Captain or Vice Captain.

Singles Knockout

Date **Saturday 25th May 2024**

Additional Conditions of Play

1. Entries close as at the qualifying round. Entries must be made at the time of entering the daily competition and payment of \$2.
2. Top 32 players will qualify and enter a seeded draw. If there is a tie for 32nd position then the 32nd position will be decided by countback.
3. In each match, the player with the lower handicap plays off scratch. His/Her opponent's handicap is similarly reduced. Shots shall be taken off the stroke index on the score card. Maximum handicap is 36.
4. Competition to be played in accordance with the rules of golf.
5. All matches will be played on or before the due date unless prior approval has been granted by the Captain or Vice Captain

Fred Morecroft Foursomes Championships

This event honours the life and contributions to golf by Fred Morecroft. Fred won our club championship a total of 17 times, nine East Gippsland Singles titles, five Gippsland Singles titles, our Open Championship four times and was Victorian Country Champion on three occasions. In total Fred won over 100 titles in East Gippsland alone. He was also made Life Member of Bairnsdale, Lakes Entrance and Orbost for his contributions to each of those clubs.

Date : **Saturday 29th June 2024**

Entry is on the day and the event is 18 holes of Foursomes stroke play. Only entitled members are eligible to have their name on the honour board.

Potter Family Memorial

The Potter Family were represented in our Club since 1904 by Douglas, Roy and Alan Potter. Both Douglas and Roy beside being excellent golfers were also Life Members of the Club. Alan had a long career as a top golfer in our Club and played right through his golfing life in the shadow of Fred Morecroft. Alan still managed to win our Club Championship seven times and represented East Gippsland at Country Week for over twenty years.

The event is played on the **Saturday of the July Monthly Medal.**

Alan Archibald Memorial Day

Alan was a long time member and President at the time we shifted from the racecourse to the current site. Alan was a keen golfer and an equally keen bowler and he and others made sure that a bowls section was added to our club. One of the bowling greens has been named in his honor.

The event is a 4 Ball Best Ball Stableford and trophies are donated by David and Jenny Archibald.

Women's Conditions of Play

Pace of Play

To ensure "pace of play" and in the spirit of the game players must move on the time sheet when directed by the starter.

General

- Inspect the notice board before the start of play for any temporary local rules and other information.
- Women Members taking part in any Championships, Pennant Match, or Knock-Out competition shall have precedence over general non-competition play on the course.
- All ties in major competitions shall be decided by play-off holes, stipulated in COP for that event, unless otherwise determined by the Match Committee.
- All ties in weekly competitions will be determined by a count back.
- All Knock-Out Matches must be played off the Stroke index.
- All competitors are solely responsible for the correctness of their score that is recorded on each hole.
- Once the competitor has left the club house after play, your score will be deemed submitted.
- Every member is responsible to have the correct handicap on the day.

Play may not commence before 8.30am in the summer and 9am in the winter, and only from the 1st and 10th Tees, unless a shotgun start has been arranged by Match Committee.

- Up to 8 players, 50% of entry fee returned as prizes NTP on 8th only.
- 8-16 players, Standard Comp prize format, NTP on 8th and 11th
- 17 players and up Standard Comp prize format. NTP on all par 3's 4th , 8th , 11th , and 17th .

Good information to know.

Visitors

A member of a golf club affiliated with Golf Victoria or Golf Australia, on payment of the applicable green fee, may enter the daily club competition, subject to the approval of the Club Captain or General Manager. A reduced green fee is applicable for visitors introduced by a member.

Practice

Practice on the golf course using a maximum of two balls is permitted, but only when this does not delay any other players on the course.

Fill divots with sand.

Be aware of others - practice safely.

Chipping and Putting Greens are designated Practice Areas.

Tips to avoid slow play

Slow play is everyone's responsibility to ensure you keep up with the team in front.

On the Tee: Be ready to hit off immediately if it is your turn and it is safe.

Do not mark your scorecard when it is your turn to play; if you have the honour, play first, and then mark your card while others are teeing off.

Watch any ball hit towards the rough carefully, making note of where it should be found.

Play a provisional ball if there is a chance your ball may be lost outside a hazard or Out of Bounds.

Through the green: Be ready to move to your ball when it is safe to do so.

Do not walk to your fellow competitor's

ball and watch them play if it is safe to proceed directly to your ball.

Be ready to play when it is your turn. Assess your shot and select your club while others are playing their shot. Think about your shot before you arrive at your ball.

If it helps to speed up play, play out of turn. eg a short hitter should play before a longer hitter who has to wait for the group ahead.

Play your own ball before assisting fellow competitors in searching for lost balls.

Players searching for a ball should signal to players following them to pass and should not continue their play until those players have passed and are out of range.

On the putting green: Be ready to putt when it is your turn. Assess the line and pace of your putt whilst others are putting.

Do not unnecessarily mark your ball. Putt out whenever possible.

Leave your buggy between the green and the next tee.

Leave the green immediately your group has finished playing the hole or, if necessary to maintain pace of play, two players to proceed to the next tee while remaining players putt out.

Mark your scorecard at the next tee. Do not practice missed putts.

General: Pick up your ball immediately once you are unable to score in Stableford and Par Competition.

If you have a clear fairway in front you are out of position. You must take remedial action by speeding up play.

The low marker in each Group is responsible for the conduct of the group and for ensuring that the group does not lose its place in the field.

Care of the Course

Always enter and leave bunkers at the lowest point.

Use rakes to fill in foot and stroke marks, dragging sand toward the front of the bunker. Before leaving a bunker, replace the rake towards the centre of the bunker along the line of play.

Always carry a sand bucket and fill divots even if you did not make them.

Through the green ensure that any divots are replaced and pressed down using sand.

Repair ball pitch marks on greens.

Ensure that, when attending the flagstick, no damage is done to the putting green. Avoid standing too close to the hole and handle flagstick carefully.

The flagstick should be properly replaced in the hole before leaving the putting green.

Place all litter including cigarette butts in bins provided. Please respect that sand buckets and sand bins are not for rubbish.

Please don't leave sand buckets in the car park; kindly return them to the bucket racks or bucket trolley adjacent to the car park.

Ground staff

In order to maintain the course to a high standard, golfers must give ground staff right of way at all times

Club competitions

Eighteen-hole competitions for men from the blue tee markers are conducted on Sunday, Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday.

Eighteen-hole competitions for women from the red tee markers are conducted on Sunday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Saturday.

A nine-hole competition for men and women is also available on Friday.

Time sheets

Timesheets are electronic, accessible through the Club website or via the booking computer in the clubhouse. Phone bookings through the Golf Shop are also available.

When a time sheet is in operation, only those players entered on the sheet have the right to play.

Members can access the electronic timesheet for events from 2.00pm, fourteen days prior to the competition.

A maximum of four names can be entered on the time sheet by any one player, including the player entering the names.

The Captain, Golf Operations staff or the Manager have the discretion to alter the timeslot of any Competitor or Group.

When the time sheet is full, an electronic wait list is available online and we highly recommend all members use it, as it ensures fairness to all.

Registration

Competitors must report to the Golf Shop at least fifteen minutes before the listed tee-off time to pay the Competition entry fee and collect their pre-printed card. Players must then report to the starter within ten minutes of their tee off time and may be directed by the starter to commence their game earlier than listed.

Members who are late may be relegated to a later time slot. The Golf Shop must be notified of all cancellations or late arrivals.
